It has been a year since the fire at our Thrift Store. Thanks to help we received from many of you, we have recovered and improved that location. We depend on donations of usable items for that operation. In addition to sales, we provide clothing and other items to homeless people, burn-out victims, and other people in need. We have had a rash of vehicle repairs on our Mission vans. It has cost over \$4,000.00 altogether. Our fuel cost on 4 vans runs around \$700.00 per week. Utilities cost close to \$5,000.00 a month in the summer. Please pray with us that the Lord will continue to supply our needs. This is our toughest time of the year.

We graduated 8 men and 1 woman in our last graduation. We are housing 45 men in our men's shelter and 18 women & children in our women's shelter.

A special thanks to our board members, our staff, and volunteers who help us. And, a special thanks to all of you who support & pray for the Mission.

May the Lord bless you and your family.

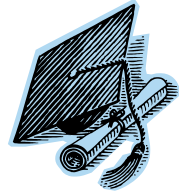
