We are still in need of help to gear up for the holidays. We are feeding more meals to the public than ever before. Any help would be appreciated so much.

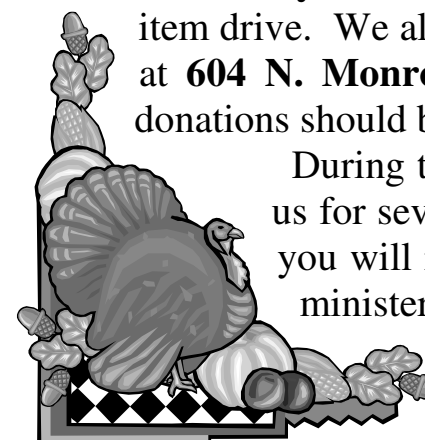
