Prepared Meals

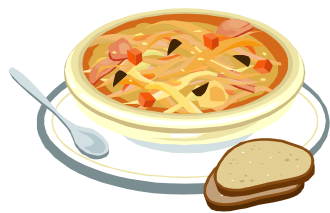
We serve meals to our residents and to the public 3 times a day, 7 days a week. We usually serve more than 7,000 meals a month.

Let's Feed a Family of Four



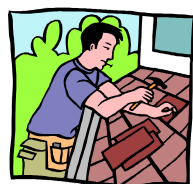
- 4 cans of vegetables
