News & Needs

Dear Supporters and Friends,

We thank you so much for your continuing support of the Mission. As this hot summer starts to wind down, we want to bring you up to date. We just had another graduation. These men and women have completed our Bible-based program and should be ready to move on to a new life. Sharon Boykins and our Women's and Children's Ministry have been a special blessing to many displaced women and children that were in desperate need of help. The most important service we provide is often overlooked. We show each and every one who comes to us how much God loves them. As we share God's plan of salvation, we let them know how trusting in the Lord can change their lives.

News

Needs

At the present time, the Mission is full – 44 men, 16 women, and 3 children. This is our most difficult time of the year. Our funds are very low, and our need is great now! We run 4 vehicles full-time; fuel is averaging over \$350.00 per week. Last month's utilities for our 8 locations totaled \$5,000.00 due to extreme heat. And, we are still feeding over 7,000 meals per month. Also, our non-perishable food items are low.

Many of you have given extra to help with our needs, and we thank you for your help. The Lord has blessed us through these many years. He has always supplied our needs through many caring people. We hope and pray you will be able to help us to meet these needs.

Thank you, and may the Lord bless you and your family.

Groceries

Lately, we've had 2 - 3 families a day requesting emergency food bags (a big increase), so the food you shared with us will be distributed quickly! The need continues, and we'd be glad for any part of the list you can give. These are the items we like to include in food bags . . .

- 4 cans of vegetables
- 4 cans of fruit
- 4 cans of meat (tuna, beans, chili, etc.)
- 4 cans of soup
- 1 package of dry beans
- 1 package of cereal or grits
- 1 box of crackers
- 1 package of pasta, rice, etc.
- 1 jar of peanut butter
- 1 jar of jelly or jam
- 1 bar of soap

* We also welcome food to be used at our daily meals! Right now, our cooks would be glad to have some canned meats (like tuna, chicken, or beef stew).
