As we begin August with rising heating and cooling cost, we face many repair and maintenance projects here. We are currently replacing the kitchen floor which has grown weak from the many years of constant use. We plan on replacing the vinyl floor with a tile floor which we feel will hold up better to the wear and tear of daily use. Years ago we chose to go with vinyl due to the reduced cost but it has not held up as well as we thought so we now know we should have stayed with tile, we consider this a lesson sorely learned. Thank you for all your support without it would not feed, clothes, and house those who come to us in their hour of need.

#### Food needs

Our need for food is ongoing . . . we serve a lot of meals every day. And, some families come to our office in need of a food bag. **We need help restocking our “pantry.”** We welcome gifts of non-perishable food. Depending on the current needs, your gift of food will be used here at the Mission for our on-site meals, or it will be given to a family in need.

- Here’s a list of items we like to put in each emergency food bag . . .
- Can you donate a full bag? Or a part of a bag? Or just a few items? Any amount will help!

#### **Let’s Feed a Family of Four**

4 cans of vegetables  
 4 cans of fruit  
 4 cans of meat (tuna, beans, chili, etc.)  
 4 cans of soup  
 1 package of dry beans  
 1 package of cereal or grits  
 1 box of crackers  
 1 package of pasta, rice, etc.  
 1 jar of peanut butter  
 1 jar of jelly or jam  
 1 bar of soap
