News

As we get into the later part of the year. I just want to thank you for all of your support and prayers! As everyone knows we had to close the Ladies Ministry. Please keep us in your prayers and consider us for a monthly Mission support so we can reopen a woman's dorm in the coming months. We have some repairs needed to the house and the need of a dorm mother! Please pray that God sends us both! Albany needs another shelter for woman and children! Help us be the hands and feet of Jesus and minster to women and children of Albany and the surrounding areas.

At this present time, the Mission has open beds. This is our most difficult time of the year. Our funds are lower than this time last year, and our need is even greater now! We run 5 vehicles full-time; fuel is averaging over \$500 per week. Last month's utilities for our 14 locations totaled over \$6000 due to higher rates and we are still feeding over 10,000 meals per month. Also, We can use more non-perishable food items to keep our supplies for running low.

Many of you have given extra to help with our needs, and we thank you for your help. The Lord has blessed us through these many years. He has always supplied our needs through many caring people. We hope and pray you will be able to help us to meet these needs. Lastly, we publish many free books. These books can be found on our website @ albanyrescuemission.org or you may stop by our Main Office for any of our books or other materials. We also have some of our books in Spanish (By Request In Advance) if needed.

~Building Plans & Mission Needs~

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! Just a quick introduction. My name is Applis McGrady and I am the new CFO of the Albany Rescue Mission. I am the daughter of Brother Larry Hample and Sister Catherine Hample. I have been in Albany since 1986, when I returned from Japan. I have 4 boys and 1 girl and 9 grandbabies!! I am very excited to see what God has in store for me in this new chapter of my life!! I look forward to serving him and our community!

I am going to try to update you on our Men's ministry and our Kitchen Outreach! Currently we have all the men in one dorm. Our goal is to get them back to the main campus where the chapel, kitchen and office are. Your monetary donations make this possible and we thank you from the bottom of our hearts! Before we can do this, we need to renovate our 100-year-old dorms!! We are asking for prayers, lots of prayers, donations for the building fund, and any contractors to come and make a bid!

Currently we are doing about 10,000 meals a month. Thank you to all of you who donate canned goods and ready to eat meals!! We cannot do this without you! Amanda and I have been going to the Feeding the Valley food bank and recovering 1000's of pounds of food! We get 30 cases of fresh fruit a week and access to frozen and canned goods. We do have to pay a small fee as the food is weighed up by the pound. So far 100% of what we have recovered we have distributed to the community. We fill our picnic tables daily and they come!

We do have a new Facebook page. If you are not following us, please do. You can get the day-to-day information as we post 3 times a day. It also has our Amazon wish list. This list is for the mission's needs to help with the cost of running it. It is fast and easy and is shipped to the Mission office. Some of our other needs:

- 1: #10 cans of vegetables(For hot meals)
- 2: Water (we give out over 100 bottles a day)
- 3: Canned meats
- 4: Any size diapers
- 5. Canned fruits and veggies (feeding a family of 4 bags)
- 6. Reusable grocery bags (to store feeding a family of 4 food)

Once again thank you for all your prayers and donations! We really cannot do this without you!
