What an amazing God we serve! As we enter the lean months of the year, we are leaning on Him to provide. Sometimes it can be a bit overwhelming. As we have said before, we are trying to update / renovate our 100 -year-old dorm. We have 1 of the 4 apartments done at this time. Satan is trying to discourage us with a lot of unforeseen obstacles. We had a water pipe break and that set us back over 5k. We ask that you keep us in your prayers to raise the 30k we will need to renovate each apartment. Also pray that the Lord provides a good Christian contractor! Since we lost our beloved John in March of this year, we have not been able to find a reliable contractor.

We also ask for prayers for my Father Brother Larry Hample. He has many health issues since the last newsletter and has been in the hospital and we have many follow-up appointments for him scheduled. Please pray for my Mom Sister Catherine Hample, she has been trying to get to all his appointments, while trying to monitor his health the best she can.

Praise... we have been able to fill over 150 emergency food bags each month!!! That is a lot of cans. Here is a little breakdown.

Meat – 600 cans, Vegetables – 600 cans, Fruit – 600 cans, Peanut Butter – 150 jars, Jelly – 150 jars, 300lbs of rice & beans, 150 cartons of milk, 600 boxes of pasta, 150 boxes of crackers, 150 boxes of cereal, 150 boxes of cookies / sweets, that's all God putting in your heart to give!!! Thank you for showing up and showing out for the Albany Rescue Mission!

We can NOT do this without YOU!!! May God bless and keep you as we go into the next half of this year!!!
