She is now 15 weeks pregnant with the baby doctors once said she would never be able to have. We know God is still working miracles.






Thank you to all who have contributed to the Thrift Store and our Feeding Program! We are so blessed. We ask you to give as the Lord leads you! God is Faithful. We are feeding more these days as school is out. We are also providing more "Feed A Family Of Four" Food Bags. As fast as they go out more comes in. we are praying for a storage solution. We thank you all for your generosity in providing for those who are without.

Canned Food & Hygiene Product Drive: The Albany Rescue Mission is currently holding a Canned Food & Hygiene Product Drive. This time of year is especially important as we work to restock our shelves with non-perishable food items and essential hygiene products for those we serve each day.

Each month, we provide more than 7,000 meals to our residents and members of the community. In addition, we distribute approximately 150 emergency food bags and 150 hygiene bags to families and individuals in need every month.

Our kitchen staff would greatly appreciate donations of large #10 size canned food items to help prepare daily meals for those staying at the mission. We are also asking for help stocking our emergency food bags. Would you consider donating all or part of a food bag for a family in need?

Below is a list of suggested food and hygiene items we like to include in our care bags. This is also a wonderful opportunity for youth groups, churches, schools, businesses, and community organizations to come together for a meaningful service project and make a real difference in the lives of others.
